## **THE VOICE Video Competition Guide Lines and tips**

- 1) THE CREW is rated for General Exhibition so in designing your clip remember it needs to be 'G' Rated.
- 2) If you are using music in your clip make sure its either original or copyright free. You can download copyright free songs from the RESOURCES section on THE CREW web site.
- 3) Ask the people you film to sign a release form and send it in with your entry. This is to make sure you have their permission to use your images.

- 5) It's a good idea to shoot your video over a short period of time especially id you are using actors. You never know when someone will get their hair cut or change their appearance and this could cause some problems in your video.
